The Role

The Naze is a unique coastal landscape of outstanding geological and biological importance. As the most easterly peninsula in Essex it is an important site for migrating birds and boasts a number of different habitats, both terrestrial and marine.

The Naze is a special and important place for many reasons and is a place where wildlife thrives, from insects living in the soft cliffs to the familiar barn owl hunting over the grasslands. The Naze is the gateway into Hamford Water National Nature Reserve, an area of international importance due to the number of wildfowl and waders that it supports and is itself a sanctuary for migrating and nesting birds, from Dark Bellied Brent Geese to Sedge Warbler and Whitethroat.

The Centre offers an education space, a gift shop and refreshments, run by a friendly team and wonderful and passionate volunteers.

As a Centre Assistant, post holder will work within retail and food and beverage and serving customers within in this visitor engagement role.

Working as part of a visitor centre team, the post holder will need to be a team player who can engage in a welcoming and professional way with our visitors both in retail and food and beverage - ensuring excellent customer service is always at the forefront. The successful applicant will be using the till, preparing and serving hot and cold refreshments, clearing tables, restocking retail stock and engaging to customers.

We are looking for a friendly individual with an interest in customer service to join Essex Wildlife Trust in this visitor engagement role. Our profits from the Nature Discovery Centre's are used to fund the conservation, educational and other work key of the Trust.

Job Description

- Meet and greet at all stages of the visitor interaction.
- Work within retail (stocking shelves, stock rotation, merchandising, servicing on the till).
- Work within the café (preparing and servicing hot and cold refreshments).
- Ensure all front of house areas are well presented.
- To ensure the centre maximises opportunities to promote and recruit Essex Wildlife Trust members.
- Promotion of roundups/donations.
- Following daily cleaning schedules.
- Adhere to Health and Safety, COSHH procedures and safe systems of working.
- Receiving Centre deliveries and Goods Out.
- Record wastage accurately and in a timely manner.
- Correctly follow all EPOS process and procedures.
- Assist with regular centre stock takes and comply with all stock control recommendations.

- The Nature Discovery Centre is open every day, with the exception for Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
- Working on a rota basis between Monday and Sunday, including most weekends and bank holidays. Most shifts will be at the weekend within the centre operating hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm.
- Expectation to support other Nature Discovery Centres as required.
- The role requires an interest in working for a charity that is determined to protect wildlife for the future and for the people of Essex.

Terms

These roles are fixed term to cover maternity leave. Both roles working 15 hours per week on a rota basis including most weekends and bank holidays. All shifts will be within the centre operating hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm. The salary is £8,923.20 per annum (FTE £22,308). This salary will increase from 01 April 2025 (rates to be confirmed).

Annual leave entitlement will be at 26 days per annum plus Bank Holidays pro-rata for the duration of the contract.
